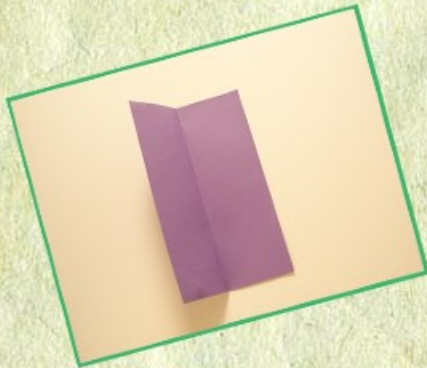




Paper AirPlanes

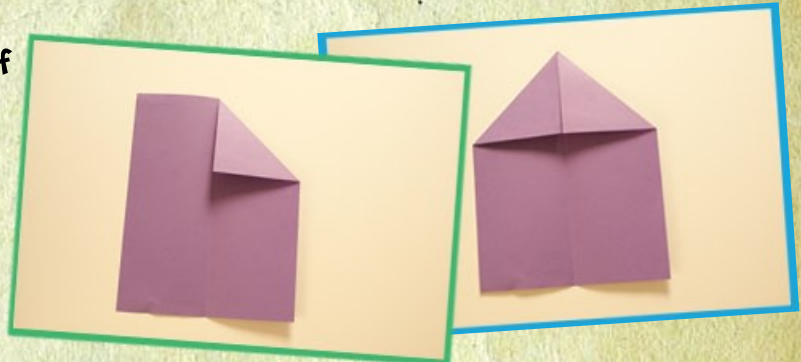
You will need:

- 1 sheet of 8 ½ " x 11" PaPer
(Try to use recycled PaPer)



1. FOLD an 8 ½" x 11" Piece of PaPer in half, lengthwise. **RUN** your finger along the fold to 'Press' a sharp Crease into the PaPer. **OPEN** the folded PaPer, make sure a visible Crease shows. This helps as a guide to make the remaining folds.

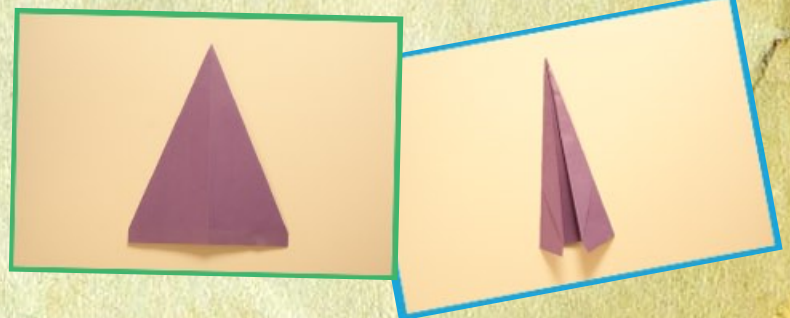
2. FOLD Down the top corners so the corners of the PaPer meet at the folded centre line. This will leave you with a PaPer that has a square Bottom and Pointed top.



3. Take the outside angled corners of the PaPer and fold those corners to the centre of the PaPer.



4. Turn the folded Pointed PaPer over so the top is smooth & fold the outside folded edges again into the centre line.



5. Keeping all the folds in Place, fold the Centre Crease., **OPEN** the 'wings', **HOLD** the Plane By the Bottom and **toss** into the air!
